

The College of Staten Island (CSI/CUNY) offers nationally recognized English as a Second Language (ESL) programs for students who have been admitted to CSI/CUNY, and for adults who have not been admitted to CSI/CUNY and need to improve their English language skills.

This guide was created to assist all members of our campus community with making an informed decision about the ESL program that is best for them at CSI/CUNY.

Pages 1-3 list the purpose and contact information of CSI's ESL programs for students admitted to CUNY. Pages 4-5 organize important information for students admitted to CUNY, to aid their decision-making:

Students admitted to CSI/CUNY have up to two academic years to meet CUNY's proficiency standards in college-level English language reading and writing, through developmental classes and or pre-college programs.



Immersion

Immersion is designed for students who have been admitted to CSI. This program offers free intensive instruction in English (reading and writing) during the summer and winter intersessions. Immersion also offers in- and out-of-class tutoring and counseling for college readiness.

CUNY Language Immersion Program (CLIP)

The CUNY Language Immersion
Program (CLIP) is a low-cost
intensive ESL program for incoming
CUNY students who have been
accepted to CUNY but need to
improve their academic English skills
before taking credit-bearing courses.
Students do not use their financial
aid. CLIP also offers college and
career readiness skills development,
individualized advisement, and
tutoring.

Over 60% of CLIP CSI students who completed the program in 2017-18 achieved a 3.0 GPA or higher their 1st year of college.

ESL Programs:

Admission to CSI/CUNY is Required

Upon acceptance to CSI/CUNY, freshmen and transfer students are required to take the ESL Accuplacer. CSI's Testing Office will reach out to all qualifying students to schedule a time to take the ESL Accuplacer. Students should periodically check their emails and SPAM folders. After students complete the test their scores will be listed in their CUNYfirst account. Students who score over a 105 are automatically placed in ENG 111, and are considered proficient. Students who have taken the ESLD test within the last 2 years can opt out of taking the ESL Accuplacer.


English Language Institute (ELI)
